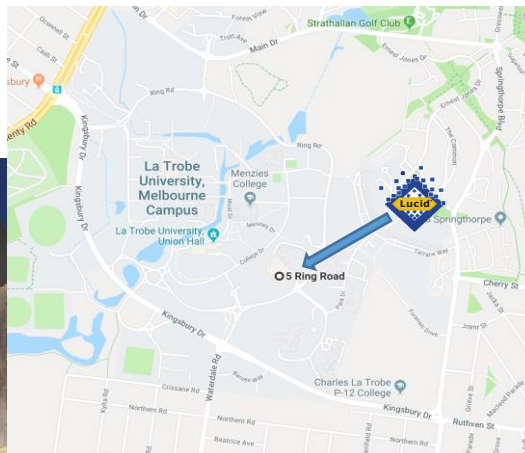

- Visitors may require a pass to access parts of the building - please ask at reception



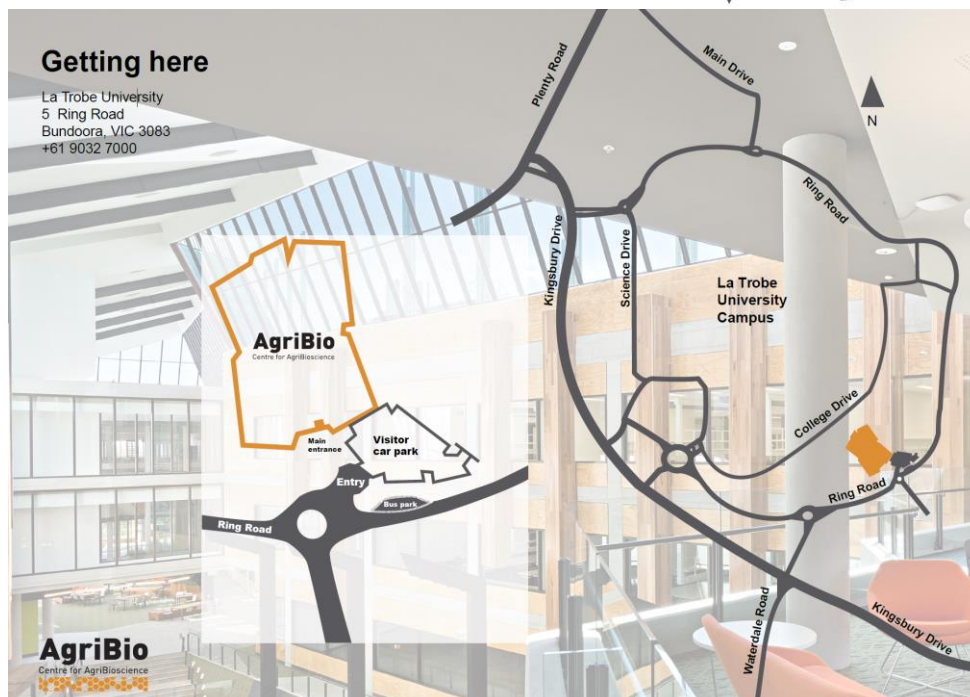
